GEAR

- Name your staff:
 - Name of the owner
 - Subcamp (Alaleiri) name
 - Camp troop (Leirilippukunnan) name
- Everyone is responsible for their own gear

GEAR

- It is recommendable to pack everything in plastic bags in the backpack
- Take separate day backpack to be carried during the day
- You need two waterproof covers for your big backpack and day backpack



TEMPUS18

PERSONNAL MEDICATION AND FIST AID

- Personal medication
 - Allergia, diabetes, migrene, etc.
- Painkillers that you are accustomed to (such as. ibuprofeen, parasetamol)
- moisturizer
- plaster
- Blister bandages
- Elastic bandage
- Menstrual
- Menthol pills or others in case of sore throat
- Lip balm

PERSONNAL MEDICATION AND MARKING

- All medication must be in their original package
 - instructions included
- Medication must be protected from moist
- Info your nearest leader:
 - Medication you use
 - Instructions when to give them
 - Ask more guidance in case you have medication that requires freezer temperature

ELECTRONICAL EQUIPMENT

- Usage of social media and the influence on Scout organization in positive sense
- Scout insurance does not cover cell phones kept in the camp
- During nighttime and programs cell phones are resting (read: silenced)
 - Unless you are advised to use one during the program
- Participants can load their cellphones with their own carry on chargers.
- Secretly filming and bullying in general is strictly forbidden

SHOPS AND CAFÉS

- There is a shop and several cafés in the camp area
- You can pay with cash or card
 - Taking a little bit of cash with you is recommended, since we can't guarantee that the card payment will always work.

DAILY ROUTINES

- In order to have a smooth transfer and food rhythm everything is scheduled carefully
- With exact schedules save and fluent day to day camp is going to happen

DAILY ROUTINES

- Scheduled routines include for instance
 - Sleeping time
 - Wake up call
 - Food
 - Program
 - Swimming and washing times

LIVING IN THE CAMP

- Camp troop (leirilippukunta) is 50-100 participants groups
- Camp troop includes one or more troops
- Camp troop is the participants home during the camp week

GENERAL SCHEDULE OF THE DAY

- Wake up and morning routines
- Breakfast
- Program valley
- Lunch
- Afternoon program valley
- Dinner
- Free time / other program
- Evening snack
- Silence

FOOD

- 4 times a day
- Sub camp
 - About 500 participants
 - Includes special diets
- Participants wash their own plates and forks etc after each meal
- Plates and fork etc is kept at the camp troop in a tote bag



TEMPUS18

WASHING UP

- If there is no rain, there will be sand in the air
- Daily
- Showers
- Participants must have their own environmental friendly washing liquids
- Avoid using strong odours

FREE TIME

- Yes there is some
- Mainly between dinner and evening snack
 - Excluding special programs such as opening event
- Shops
- Cafeteria
- Side program
- Old and new friends

CAMPING - SLEEPING

- Tents
 - Space is limited camp troops are guided to have big tents
- Camp circumstances
 - Sleeping in the tents during the camp
 - Keep your gear dry
 - Collect your gear and keep them in your backpack mainly / keep 'em safe
 - Safety in the tent is secured with order

SAFETY – GETTING LOST

- In case you get lost
 - Everybody must know your own sub camp and camptroops
 - Own name and troop
- Guidance
 - Grown ups in the camp
 - Security team at the camp keeps up the order

SAFETY - MOVING AROUND

- In groups or with a pair
 - Never alone
- Have your camp scarf and wrist band with you during all times
- You need permission to leave camp troop from an adult
- Moving to the programs and food place with your camp troop

HEALTH

- Camp has
 - Camp hospital
 - Nurses
- Camp troop has their own first aid gear in addition to participants personal first aid gear

CHALLENGE DURING THE CAMP

- Scheduled and guided week in the middle of the summer is a new thing to a kid
- Earlier camps have proofed that adjusting to the camp schedules has been challenging
- 2000 participants causes queues
